based on, remained close friends until Shea's death in 2005.

- Abagnale is a consultant and lecturer for the FBI academy and field offices. He also runs Abagnale & Associates, a financial fraud consulting company.

5 TRUE FACTS ABOUT FRANK

Warning: If you know nothing about the storyline, you may want to read this after the performance.

- 1. Abagnale's first con was at 15 years old. His dad gave him a gasoline credit card and a truck to commute to his part-time job. Instead of gas, Abagnale used the card to buy tires and other items at the gas station, then he would return them for cash. He used the cash to go on dates. He quickly rang up a bill totaling \$3,400.
- 2. Between the age of 16 and 18, while posing as a Pan Am pilot, Abagnale flew on more than 250 flights to 26 countries, all for free. He was also able to stay at hotels for free and charged his food to the airline as well.
- 3. Abagnale pretended to be a Chief Resident Pediatrician at a Georgia Hospital. He left after 11 months, when an infant almost died from oxygen deprivation under his care because he didn't know what a nurse meant when she said, "blue baby."
- 4. Abagnale failed the Louisiana Bar exam twice before passing it after only eight weeks of study. He said he passed because "they allowed you to take it over and over, so it was really a matter of figuring out what you got wrong."
- 5. Abagnale escaped prison twice after he was arrested. Once was from an airplane as it was turning onto a taxiway in New York. The other was by convincing a guard he was an undercover prison inspector.


